NOTICE OF RACE

Commodore Cup December 3&4, 2011, Levin Memorial January 14 & 15, 2012, Walker Cup February 4 & 5, 2012

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 - 2012. The organizing authority for the above regattas is ISCRYA and the host is Coral Reef Yacht Club.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the US Sailing Association and International Star Class Rule Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA) rule 31.1.3 will not apply.
- 1.3 Sail numbers shall be those entered on the entry form with no substitution unless approved by the PRO.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to Star Class boats which are in compliance with ISCYRA rules 21, 26, 29 and 30.

4 FEES

There will be a \$75 entry fee.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

Saturday for each of the above regattas: 0830 hours – 1000 hours.

Racing: Up to five races may be conducted.

Races scheduled on Saturday for each of the above regattas will have the first warning at 1125 hours.

Races scheduled for Sunday for each of the above regattas will have the first warning at 1055 hours.

If the Race Committee intends to start an additional race on the same day it will display (with no sound) the second substitute for a second race or the third substitute for a third race while boats are finishing. This changes US Sailing prescription 12.3, appendix L.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – will be available at registration

7 VENUE

The racing area will be on Biscayne Bay approximately two miles from Coral Reef Yacht Club.

8 THE COURSES

The *Race Courses* are described in ISCYRA rule 34.3.

9 SCORING

The scoring system will be in accordance with RRS A4.

- (a) one race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta, and
- (b) when five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

Trophies will be awarded to skippers and crew placing 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Masters

11 WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INJURY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
